Introduction:

Lisa Marie Citta is a ten year veteran with the North Platte Police Department. She is currently assigned to Patrol Division as a Police Investigator. Lisa performs her duties as an investigator by taking calls for service and conducting traffic patrol. Lisa was previously assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division where she performs her duties as an Investigator in following up cases, working death investigations, drug cases and other matters not assigned to the patrol division Lisa is a certified Drug Recognition Expert (DRE). She attended extensive training to attain this certification which gives her the knowledge training and resources to detect impaired drivers under the influence of drugs. Lisa is one of two officers with this department to hold this certification. Lisa is also a Field Training Investigator who trains new police officers with North Platte Police Department. She is an Advisor for the North Platte Police Explorers program and mentors young boys and girls who are interested in a career in Law Enforcement.

Lisa is a 2005 graduate of O'Neill High School. After graduation, she attended Dana College in Blair where she earned Bachelor's degrees in Criminal Justice and Social Work. She earned her degrees from Dana in May, 2009 with an honor of Cumlaude. Lisa was a member of the Dana Golf team. The team played both during both the spring and fall semesters. Lisa maintained a full time schedule throughout college to complete both degrees within four years all while working two jobs and as a traveling member of the golf team. Lisa was promoted to her position as Police Investigator in October 2019. Lisa is also an executive officer on the North Platte Police Employees Union, serving as Secretary. Lisa is involved in her community serving on the Lincoln County Agricultural Society Board. She is the chairman on the New Building Committee.
